

Daily Morning Prayer – Rite I

The Invitatory and Psalter

- Start on Page 42 with, “O Lord, open thou our lips”.
- *Gloria Patri* (Page 42)
- Use the Antiphon appointed for the season (read before and after the *Venite*).
- The *Venite* (Page 44)
 - In Easter week until the Day of Pentecost, use *Pascha nostrum* (Page 46) instead of the *Venite*
- The *Psalm or Psalms Appointed*
- *Gloria Patri* (Page 46)

The Lessons

- Old Testament Reading (Open with, “A reading from...”; close with, “the Word of the Lord”)
- Use the Canticle appointed for the season:
 - No. 4 - *Benedictus Dominus Deus* (Page 50)
 - Advent: No. 11 - *Surge, illuminare* (Page 87)
 - Lent: No. 14 - *Kyrie Pantokrator* (Page 90)
 - Easter: No. 8 – *Cantemus Domino* (Page 85)
- New Testament Reading (Open with, “A reading from...”; close with, “the Word of the Lord”)
- Use the Canticle appointed for the season:
 - No. 7 – *Te Deum laudamus* (Page 52)
 - Advent and Lent: No. 4 - *Benedictus Dominus Deus* (Page 50)

The Prayers

- Start on Page 54 with, “The Lord be with you”.
- The *Our Father* (Page 54)
- Suffrage B (Page 55)
- Collect for Sundays (Page 56). Note: not the Collect of the Day
- Read one of the Prayers for Mission (Pages 57-58)

The Closing

- Start on Page 59 with, “Let us bless the Lord”.
- Conclude on Page 59 with, “The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ...”
