There was discussion of the long anticipated outcome of work by the Charitable Aid Society / Home of the Good Shepherd to monetize some of the property managed by that Board. D Harper complimented CAS / HGS management for their obdurate persistence.

Motion: Mr Harper is authorized to continue requesting documentation from the Charitable Aid Society / Home of the Good Shepherd Board so as to provide a more complete understanding of its history and standing. (D Harper, R Wissler)
